In addition, I'd like to comment that this Saturday we will go together with Carabineros the Chile and the Union of Neighbors Councils from El Salvador, to the Agua Dulce sector (road to Potrerillos), where we will carry out a social operation, named "Seagull Mission 10", with 13 families of the Colla community, which were also affected by the rains. On the occasion we will provide WSB's and other contributions, will carry out hairdressing, repairs of ceilings, works of painting in houses, acts of dances with folk groups and also a prayer to The Pachamama (Spirit of the Earth) which is a traditional ceremony of the Collas.
